No, we're thinking in an opposite direction from automation. Judging from communications I've had with Mark, we both would prefer a "high-touch" rather than "high-tech" approach. I won't presume to state Mark's reasons for feeling this way, but here are mine:

1. The more contact with the ministry, the better. I see our job as being partly sponsors and counsellors. Sure, some people can leap on to Witt and start going strong, e.g. Marc, but others might need a bit of hand-holding and even some advice. An example of this that I mentioned to Mark was my everlasting embarrassment at treating Ben the Guy as though he were some Louis XIV. I didn't know at the time that sometimes you're just Ben the Guy and not Ben the King Who Must Be Toadied To. A form can't advise you or offer encouragement when needed, but Michael took pity on me and clued me in. (In fact, he clued me in on lots of things that prevented my stumbling all over the place.)

2. There's already far too much automation in the world. Wouldn't it be great to call a big company and actually get a human? Wouldn't it be great for a prospective to have the Ministry stay in contact throughout the process, emailing texts and documents when needed? Automated forms give no sense of actual human contact, and human contact is what this is all about, more or less, yes?

3. A hands-on approach would give the prospective that Talossa gives a damn whether the prospective stays around or not. A fill-in form won't do that-- in fact, the opposite impression might result.

I truly believe that this approach will increase prospectives, and might also help in screening a bit. The personal touch means more and more nowadays. Mark and I intend to provide it!

Hmm. I guess the best way to explain a major key is that it is a set of two tetrachords (group of four notes) with the same pattern of whole- and half-steps. Take the D Major scale for instance: D E F# G A B C# D. (D E F# G) and (A B C# D) have the same pattern: a whole step between the first/second and second/third notes and a half step between third/fourth notes.

Another way to think of it is C to C on the piano; all white keys. Do re mi fa sol la ti do.

A mode is a mixture of tetrachords that are specifically outlined. I'll include [this website](#); you'll have to scroll to the bottom to the section called Chord Qualities. Basically, using the white keys on a piano with the key of C as the reference point, Dorian mode would be D-D, Lydian would be F-F, and so on and so forth.

In light of the illumination of the Organic Law, the specific duties of the Minister of Defence shall be as follows:

1. To be the spearhead of Talossa's Invincible Moral Support in any military conflicts in which Talossa may have a part
2. To monitor the status of Talossa's national security and keep the Seneschál, Cabinet, Monarch, and country abreast of same
3. To monitor the world at large and keep the Seneschál informed of any reasons to invoke Talossa's Invincible Moral Support in a Talossan-style military fashion, in other words, lend our Invincible Moral Support to a military conflict of whatever sort or other types of conflict
4. To enlighten whoever may ask of Talossa's not having any military or weapons and of Talossa's lack of any desire whatsoever under heaven or on earth to have such though we hope such inquiries never come to pass
5. To, if his judgment says it is prudent, to maintain or delegate the maintenance of the Ministry's online presence
6. To be the chief advisor to the Seneschál on all matters of military importance not just for us, but also for our allies, friends, and enemies.

**Art. XI: Sec. 8. The King shall appoint a member of the Government to be Distáin (Deputy Seneschál) on the advice of the Seneschál. The Distáin shall act in the place of the Seneschál if the latter should die, or be unable to fulfil his duties due to medical reasons or absence from the country, until a new Seneschál shall be appointed.**

In light of the illumination of the Organic Law, the specific duties of the Distáin (Deputy Seneschál) shall be as follows:

1. To keep abreast of all governmental and kingdom of developments
2. To be an "acting" Seneschál should the Seneschál be absent for any reason
3. To be available to assist the other members of the Cabinet in whatever capacity should come up keeping in mind the general expectations of the Cabinet and Credenza

Additionally, the Deputy Seneschál shall also serve as **Keeper of the Hatchments** and **Minister to the Provinces** unless otherwise dictated by the Seneschál.

The Organic duties of the **Foreign Minister** are as follows:

**Art. XI: Sec. 3. The Foreign Minister shall be in charge of all official correspondence between the Kingdom and foreign powers.**

In light of the illumination of the Organic Law, the duties of the Foreign Minister shall be as follows:

1. To be the liaison between the Kingdom of Talossa and all non-Talossan media outlets, non-Talossan governmental agencies of any sort, individuals seeking more information though it is perfectly permissible and appropriate to forward such prospective prospectives to the Immigration Minister.
2. To be Talossa's "ambassador to the world" along with the Seneschál and Monarch as well as, truly, everyone else in Talossa
3. To be the chief advisor to the Seneschál on any reason why Talossa's relations with any other country or with any group, organization, or individual not a part of Talossa should change. This involves keeping up with world events such as the Chechen people's use of terrorist tactics given what happened last year in Moscow.
4. To be the chief co-advisor to the Seneschál, along with the Minister of Propaganda as to Talossa's reputation in the world

This Prime Dictate shall be amended by the re-issuance of the entirety of this Prime Dictate with all relevant changes. The new Prime Dictate shall render this Prime Dictate null and void in its entirety.

## **A PD to amend the general duties and expectations of the Cabinet and Credenza**

I, Gödafrieu Válcadác'h, Seneschál del Regipäts Talossán, with all duly vested executive authority and stuff, do hereby PROMULGATE this PRIME DICTATE.

WHEREAS I have felt a need to add to the general duties and expectations of the Cabinet and Credenza as well as that of the Seneschál, I have amended same as follows:

*NOTE: All Organic citations in this document are from the 1997 Organic Law as amended on 14 October, 2003.*

For the purposes of this Prime Dictate, the following from the 1997 Organic Law as amended on Wednesday, 15 October, 2003 applies. The following lists all Cabinet posts that are constitutionally-mandated:

**Art. XI: Sec. 1. The King appoints and dismisses members of the Government (Cabinet), and their subordinates, on the advice of the Seneschál. The Government consists of the Seneschál, the Distáin, the Foreign Minister, Defence Minister, Immigration Minister, and Minister of Stuff. Various other ministries may also be appointed as the Seneschál sees fit.**

**Art. XI: Sec. 2. Cabinet Ministers are responsible to the Seneschál, whom they advise and from whom they receive direction, and exercise state power with his consent.**

To all the other Members of the Cabinet not specified in the 1997 Organic Law, the following applies for the purposes of this Prime Dictate:

**Art. XI: Sec. 7. Beyond these general guidelines, the duties of Ministers will be set by tradition and expediency.**

### **Of the use of gender-specific, or "inclusive", language**

To ease the reading of this very long document and to aid the smooth flow of language, I have elected to use the traditional masculine usages rather than the newer "his or her", "his/her", or "h/er". It is my hope that context will be the signal that "his or her" is meant, and if it does not, then I will be explicit about such occurrences.

This shall apply to every Prime Dictate I have issued thus far, this Prime Dictate, and all future Prime Dictates I issue.

## General expectations of the Seneschál, Cabinet, and Credenza

1. All are expected to form fool-proof systems of deputization which will allow their ministries to function even in the Minister's absence. All are expected to enact as much redundancy in staffing of deputies as possible to allow for as many unforeseen happenings as possible. For example, if the Minister of XYZ goes on vacation for two weeks and will not be online or available during that time or if he becomes sick, then the "First Deputy Minister of XYZ" shall be the "Acting" Minister, and if this person should die or otherwise be unable to fulfill his duties as "acting" Minister, then a "Second" Deputy shall be ready to take charge. If possible, there could be a Third, Fourth, Fifth Deputy, etc., etc.,... All members of the Cabinet and Credenza as well as the Seneschál are expected to keep all appropriate persons informed as to upcoming times when they shall be "incomunicado".

2. All are expected to adhere to deadlines. However, if a deadline cannot be met, the Cabinet/Credenza member is expected to inform the Seneschál who will make arrangements. Such a missed deadline, one which has been handled in this fashion, shall not count against said member. In regard to their upline, every deputy in the PM's administration is expected to extend the same courtesy to his upline.

However, if a deadline comes and goes *without* an explanation or communication from said member, and if this happens three times to the member in any single continuous term of any Seneschál, the errant Minister shall be sacked. This only applies to deadlines which have been muffed without the members informing the Seneschál of the cause and asking for an arrangement of some sort. This three-deadline rule shall be in effect only for those persons who report directly to the Seneschál.

That being said, the Seneschál shall take into account extraordinary mitigating circumstances and shall, if need be and if the situation merits such, give an appropriate pardon.

3. All are ultimately responsible for the work done or left undone by their deputies.

4. The above being said, all Cabinet and Credenza members are not to feel they must take on more responsibility than they can handle along with their non-Talossan lives. The duty of the Seneschál and his Cabinet assisted by the Credenza is to keep Talossa free, fun, and fair, and if the Cabinet is overly-burdened by work, then Talossa is all-the-poorer. If any Cabinet or Credenza member is over-burdened, *by all means* he is expected to inform the Seneschál as soon as he is able, and the Seneschál shall make appropriate arrangements.

5. All will be easy to contact by way of email or whatever mode of conversation you choose. However, such mode should be usable by most everyone else. The Whip to the Secretary of State shall be informed of all address/contact information changes.

6. A substantive presence on Wittenberg almost goes without saying.

7. The Seneschál, Cabinet, and Credenza shall not unduly burden their deputies with work. All shall copiously consult with their deputies on realistic deadlines, and all possible efforts shall be taken to avoid any repetition of the infamous "2003 Alpha Group".

8. Communication about times when one will be away from Wittenberg is essential and almost goes without saying.

9. All shall remember that their deputies are volunteers who give their time and talents to our nationette and community without any sort of temporal compensation. Theirs is a labor of love.

10. A basic working knowledge of the Organic Law as well as the laws of our nationette is a given.

11. There will be absolutely no "territorial" attitudes within the Cabinet and Credenza. "That's not my job" will **not** be tolerated nor will being a legalistic crab in regard to "jurisdiction". Everyone will

remember that these codified duties are simply to make things clear and concise for us, citizens, and prospectives. It is hoped that the Seneschál, Cabinet, and Credenza will continue to operate with the fluid grace and ease with which it has conducted business in the past.

The following paragraph from my Prime Dictate creating the Cabinet and Credenza of 9 November, 2003 is hereby rendered null and void:

“This Prime Dictate shall be amended by the re-issuance of the entirety of this Prime Dictate with all relevant changes. The new Prime Dictate shall render this Prime Dictate null and void in its entirety save for the part creating and organizing the Credenza. This shall be done to avoid the legacy of numerous scattered Prime Dictates containing a jigsaw puzzle of legislation currently in-force.”

Azul, my fellow Talossans:

Throughout my tenures as your Head of Government, I have used the Prime Dictate more prolifically than perhaps any of my predecessors. Indeed, one Talossan has communicated to me his estimation that I have issued more Prime Dictates than all of my predecessors combined; this happened long before the Halloween Crisis.

It is abundantly clear to me now that I did indeed rush ahead with the Immigration PD of 8 November, 2003 without consulting people more than I did. It is also clear to me that Talossa probably has been "numbed" to an extent by the sheer volume of Talossan laws I have been making recently. I beg all of you to look at my PM archives at [www.maricopaprovince.net](http://www.maricopaprovince.net). There you will find many, many PDs of mourning and remembrance as well as a number of PDs which brought administrative order to Maricopa province as well as put out other small fires. Look at everything I have done and just how necessary so many of my Prime Dictates have been! Step into my shoes and ask yourself what *you* would have done about Ián Miaschür's renunciation, the Senate election in Maricopa that slipped by, the de-facto SoS situation caused by Martí-Páir's being inundated by non-Talossan things, the "Celebrity Kill-Off 2003" sponsored by the Grim Reaper, and so many more things that happened.

Not all of my Prime Dictates, however, were good: 2003 Alpha Group, the Sausage, and in some ways the recent Immigration one come quickly to mind as well as my first government-formation PD of this term which caused so much trouble. That being said, every Prime Dictate and every executive decision I have made in Talossa I have made because I thought it was the best thing for Talossa at the time. I imagine this will come as a relief to some people, but I have no plans for any more Prime Dictates for the duration of my term in office. There is no foreseeable need. By way of many of the fourteen PDs I issued on 3 December, I have now established a clear mission for the Cabinet, and for the first time perhaps ever, a Talossan citizen can look to a website devoted to the Cabinet, click on any Cabinet title, and get at a document which explains what the post is for and what is expected of the person holding said post. This page can be found at [www.maricopaprovince.net](http://www.maricopaprovince.net).

There are some things, though, that scare me. I wonder if I have opened a can of legalistic worms and that, because of that, Talossa will degenerate into a legalistic nit-picky society where all we do is poke and prod at the OrgLaw all day and do nothing else. I also wonder if future PMs will be expected to do as much administratively as I. I have had an element of spare time most people don't have to devote to the functions of office, and I, for one, will give Quedéir that element of grace when he takes office. And I think everyone else will, too.

Perhaps the thing that scares me the most, though, is that the tensions between various Talossans which have been defused for now by way of the Grand Compromise will erupt once more and will throw our community for a loop. While things have been defused for now, the gunpowder is still around, still dry, and still potent. We need to rid ourselves of the gunpowder, and that is something no Talossan government, no matter who is PM, can accomplish. How we go about fixing this once and for all is something we will all have to come to grips with, whatever it may be.

I have already stated my intentions to resign, but now I clarify them in full. I shall resign the post of Seneschál del Regipäts Talossán at 11:59pm Central Standard Time on Wednesday, 31 December, 2003 at which time DPM Quedéir Castighâ of the Black Hand Party shall assume office.

As to my political future, I will, as I have said previously, remain in the Senäts. I shall also continue to hold the posts of Maricopa Secretary of State as well as Whip to the Secretary of State. However, after 1 January, my presence on Wittenberg will be reduced somewhat, though not too much to not allow me to fulfill my Senatorial and other obligations. I shall, however, resign from the Cosâ as well as from an active role in leadership of my Progressive Conservative Party. I shall give as much aid and advice to the coming Castighâ administration as I am able; Quedéir will be able to call on me for whatever answers he might need to whatever questions he might have. Once I am no longer PM, I shall collect all my archives and disseminate them to the populace.

As for immigration, I believe we are well on our way to a system of immigration which will be the clearest and most-comprehensive Talossa has ever seen. Andriëu Lorêntz and Márcüs Cantaloûr are doing a great work in the Immigration Ministry, and I could not be more-pleased. Marti-Páir Furxhéir is well on his way to being the greatest Secretary of State we have ever had (and considering his predecessors, he has had work very hard at getting to that lofty height).

Much-needed reform in the political nature of the Monarchy is afoot. The Halloween Crisis of 2003 did not happen in vain.

I am excited about Talossa! I am excited about what she can become, and excited for all of us who are a part of it, and that includes all of us. Our Twenty-Fifth anniversary is coming up, and it is going to be an exciting year!

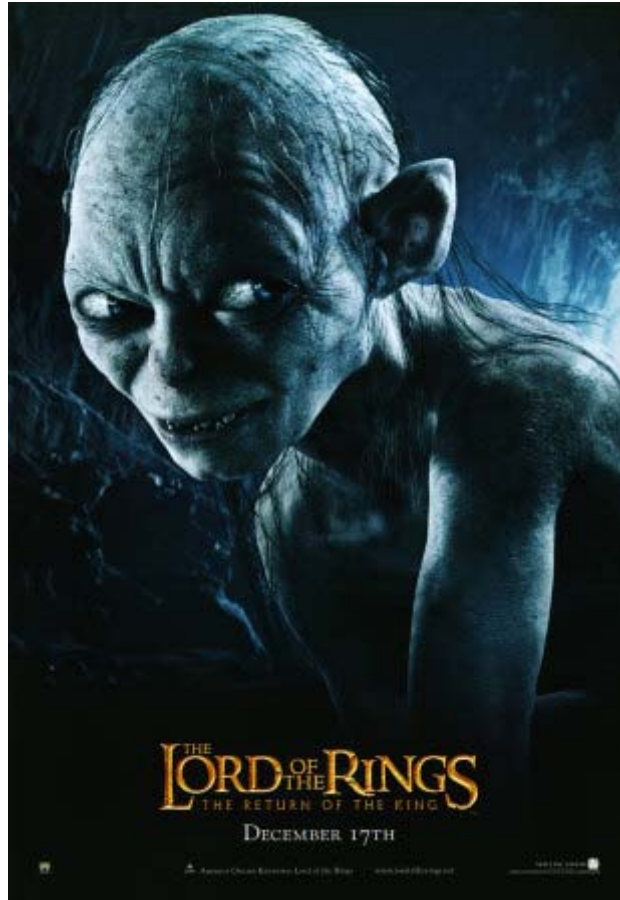

I don't know anything about Carlüs Savúls, and as such I can't comment. However, in the case of Gary, it is a question of point of view as the law is not really clear. Traditionally in most country including Canada, those serving as acting PM are also listed in official listings. As per the OrgLaw, Dixhêt Conâ was "fulfilling" the duties and responsibilities of PM. I like listing them, but it is a judgement call.

> There is nothing in the OrgLaw that says we automatically have a PM. (How do other parliamentary systems handle this? I know in Britain there is no constitutional office of "Deputy Seneschál," although some people have held the title--it is apparently a meaningless title. That's not the case in Talossa, where the DPM is a recognized office.)

According to traddition in Canada, when a Seneschál (or provincial premier) resigned, another one is sworn in immediately. This is because the PM provide his resignation to the Governor General, so if the GG is available to received the resignation, he/she is available to have someone

else sworn in. However, resignation have always been expected and everone always ensured those situation wouldn't affect the work of the government. Talossa, is somewhat different in this regard.

I like them them in there as PM, regardless of whether they were sworn in or not they were actually PM for all intent purposes and should anything important happen during that time they would have been the ones dealing with it.
